#### ↳ PERSONS CONCERNED:

#### ↳ PREREQUISITES:

- Driver's license older than 2 years, current and valid for type of vehicle and country of residence
- International Driving License (if training is followed outside of country of residence).

#### ↳ OBJECTIVES:

- To enable the participant to know the basic rules of pedagogy, to master the Vision Rules, and recognize mechanical skill when driving.
- To enable the participant to be capable of assessing other vehicle drivers.

### COURSE CONTENTS

#### ↳ Day 1

- Presentation of the Driving Rules and Vision models for SAFE driving  
Human & Mechanical Reaction Time
- Sight  
Binocular and Peripheral field of vision - Notion of distance and velocity  
Vertical/Horizontal field of Vision, Analyze of Informations
- Anticipation  
The different sources of risks and the corrective actions
- Following Distance  
Vehicle in motion, vehicle stopped, adverse conditions
- Expertise  
Driver knowledge, know-how, physical and mental ability  
Driver Behavior.

- Morning: Theory for driving assessment / Driving assessment forms  
Participants' driving assessment and Commentary Drive
- Afternoon: Practice - Commentary drive. Technique 1 of the 5 Driving Rules

#### ↳ Day 3

- Morning: Steering control. Emergency braking and avoiding
- Afternoon: Commentary Drive. Technique 2 of the 5 Driving Rules

#### ↳ Day 4

- Morning: Commentary Drive. Technique 2 of the 5 Driving Rules
- Afternoon: Full Commentary Drive assessment

#### ↳ Day 5

- Morning: Full Commentary Drive Assessment
- Afternoon: Trainee evaluation / Debrief / Round table

The participants' driving practices are evaluated during a commentary drive exercise to check and reinforce the effect of the classroom session.

### ↳ Day 7

- Defensive Driving - classroom pedagogy
- Defensive driving for Heavy Vehicles  
Ability and driving skills, Identification and analysis of road hazards, Safe distance, Drivers' ability, Review of regulation...
- Pre-Trip Inspection  
External inspection, Conduct general inspection, Vehicle posture, Cabin inspection, brakes, Wheels and rims...
- Mechanical  
Engine types, Transmission, Axles and differentials, Brake systems, Tires and rims...

### ↳ Day 8

- Practical session  
The participants' driving practices are evaluated during a commentary drive exercise to check and reinforce the effect of the classroom session.

### ↳ Day 9

- Non-articulated trucks / 4x4
- Vehicle operation  
Maneuverings, Braking techniques, Emergency procedure...
- Vehicle Handling and Handling Issues  
High centre of gravity, Adverse conditions...
- Load Security  
Securing the load, Load Anchorage Points, Gates and Fencing...

### ↳ Day 10

- Desert / Off road Driving endorsement  
Basic survival skills, Tire Pressures and Inflation Practices, Basic Desert and Off Road Driving Skills, Incident Procedures...
